

#### **JINGLES**

A jingle is a short song or tune used in advertising and for other commercial uses. Jingles are a form of sound branding. A jingle contains one or more hooks and meaning that explicitly promote the product or service being advertised, usually through the use of one or more advertising slogans. Ad buyers use jingles in radio and television commercials; they can also be used in non-advertising contexts to establish or maintain a brand image. Many jingles are also created using snippets of popular songs, in which lyrics are modified to appropriately advertise the product or service

Well-known as "Land of Festivals", the state of Gujarat celebrates a large number of festivals every year. The celebrations are complemented with music performances and traditional dances based on their rich traditions and culture. Various classical songs, drama and dance forms are practised in Gujarat which is actually popular all over the country. Most of the dance forms are very old. Some of the eminent folk dances from Gujarat are: Dandiya Raas, Garba, Tippani and Padhar.



The word Garba comes from the Sanskrit word for womb and so implies gestation or pregnancy — life. The dancers honour Durga, the feminine form of divinity.

Gujarati folk music consists of a wide variety. Bhajan, a devotional song type poetry are categorized by theme of poetry/lyrics and by musical compositions such as Prabhati, Katari, Dhol etc. The Bard traditions of Barot, Charan and Gadhvi communities has preserved and enriched the folk tradition of story telling with or without music. This includes the forms of Doha, Sorathaa, Chhand, etc. The songs and music accompanying traditional dance forms such as Garba, Dandiya Raas, Padhar, Dangi and Tippani are unique in nature. Dayro and Lokvarta are music performances where people gather to listen performer who delivers religious as well as social message through it. Marasiyas are elegiac form of music originated from Marsiya. Fattanna or Lagnageets are light form of song and music played during marriages. Bhavai and Akhyana are folk musical theatre performed in Gujarat.



The capital of Gujarat, Gandhinagar, is considered to be the greenest capital city in Asia, with almost 50% of its land covered with greenery. Till 1970, Ahmedabad was the capital city of Gujarat.



#### **GUJARAT LITERATURE**

During Bhakti Era (15th-19th century) , Jain and Hindu poets produced Gujarati literature in abundance. The prose and poetry created were aimed to encourage religion and worship. Hindu texts such as Gita, Mahabharata, Vedas, and Bhagwata became popular.



Gujarat word has originated from the Sanskrit word 'Gurjaratra', which means the "Land of Gurjaras". The Gurjara tribe ruled the region between 8th and 9th centuries C.E.
